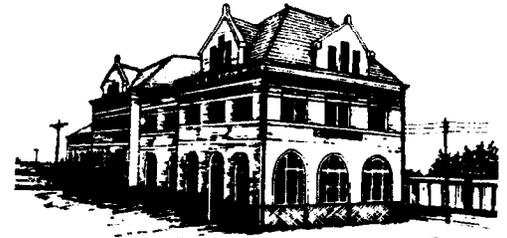

The Creston City Council met in regular session at 6:00 o'clock P.M. on the above date in the Council Chambers of the City Hall Complex with Mayor Woods presiding.

Mayor Woods administered the Oath of Office to Police Officer Tyler Rothmeyer.

Roll call being taken with the following Council members present: White, Winborn, Shelton, Wilson, Wagner and Koets. Wynn was absent.

Wilson moved seconded by Winborn to approve the agenda. All voted aye. Wynn was absent. Motion declared carried.

Shelton moved seconded by Wilson to approve the consent agenda, which included approval of minutes of regular meeting on December 15, 2009, claims of \$576,790.80, fund transfers of \$107,609.50 and beer/wine permit renewal for Fareway. All voted aye. Wynn was absent. Motion declared carried.

No one spoke during Public Forum.

A resolution was offered by White seconded by Shelton to appoint Matt Higgins to the Water Board of Trustees and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute the proper documentation. Wilson, Wagner, Koets, White, Winborn and Shelton voted aye. Wynn was absent. Resolution declared passed.

A resolution was offered by Shelton seconded by White to appoint Jerry White to the Planning & Zoning Commission and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute the proper documentation. Wagner, Koets, White, Winborn, Shelton and Wilson voted aye. Wynn was absent. Resolution declared passed.

A resolution was offered by Wilson seconded by White to approve an amendment to the engineering contract with Garden & Associates for the Cottonwood Road Reconstruction Project and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute the proper documentation. Wagner, Koets, White, Winborn, Shelton and Wilson voted aye. Wynn was absent. Resolution declared passed.

A resolution was offered by White seconded by Koets providing for Surety Bond/Blanket Position running to the City and covering the Mayor, Clerk, Treasurer and such other officers and employees as may be necessary and advisable and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute the proper documentation. Winborn, Shelton, Wilson, Wagner, Koets and White voted aye. Wynn was absent. Resolution declared passed.

Under Other Items Public Works Director Kevin Kruse let Council know the stop lights located at the intersection of Elm and Adams Streets were not working correctly due to a malfunction and he has placed them on a continuous red flash for now. He has observed the flow of traffic at both low and high-travel times and feels the traffic is running smoothly. He is asking Council to consider leaving the lights on flash-mode for a couple of weeks and reevaluate the situation at that time to decide whether they should leave them on flash-mode or turn them back to the complete cycle.

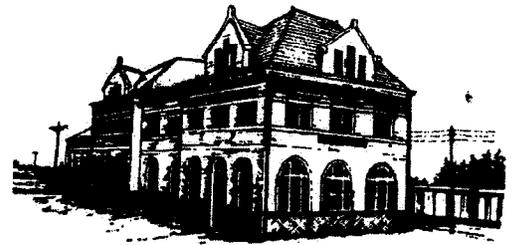

**RESOLUTION NO. 101 - 10**

**RESOLUTION TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE TOBACCO HEARING NOTICES:**

WHEREAS, the Creston City Council has been informed that two (2) tobacco permit holders have violated the conditions of their permits by permitting the sale of tobacco products to minors;

WHEREAS, the citation has been issued to the individual employee of the permit holder who allowed the sale and the permit holder has been found guilty of the violation;

WHEREAS, it is appropriate at this time to set a public hearing to determine whether the civil penalty of Three Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$300.00) for a first violation should be assessed against the permit holders involved;

WHEREAS, it is appropriate at this time to set a public hearing to determine whether the civil penalty of One Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$1,500.00) or a thirty (30) day suspension of tobacco permit for a second violation within two (2) years should be assessed against the permit holders involved.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that a hearing shall be set concerning the complaint of first violation and the complaint of second violation within two (2) years *at 6:00 o'clock, P.M. on MARCH 16, 20 10 in the Council Chambers of the Restored Depot/City Hall, Creston, IA* concerning the following permit holders:

1. American Legion - first offense
2. Farm & Home - second offense

BE AND IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the proper documentation necessary.

BE AND IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that any Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
